Artists Carola Orieta Sperman and Alejandro Rauhut are pushing the boundaries of what's expected and delivering work worthy of a second look.

- **Carola Orieta Sperman's *Reverie in Blue*** is a fusion of art, paint, photography and artificial Intelligence, revealing a new frontier where creativity is redefined. Through the lens of A.I, *Reverie in Blue* embodies a harmonious blend of human ingenuity and technological innovation, inviting contemplation on the evolving nature of artistic expression in the digital age.
- Columbian artist **Alejandro Rauhut's** series “**Exclusions**” takes the viewer on a modern-day technological journey of early 19th century cities. Using light boxes and mirrors to create effect, Rauhut's pieces depend on light to generate different nuances, where the geometric figure are turned on and off, generating different sensations depending on its state and environment. This makes them not only contemplative but interactive with the viewer. This series consists of maps of four different cities — London, New York, Paris, and Tokyo — each with a different color and geometric figure that represents a wake-up call to gratitude. Taking it one step further, there is a QR code, enabling the collector to travel via Augmented Reality through the cities.
