ART SANTA FE 2023 ANNOUNCES DATES FOR ITS 23RD ANNUAL EDITION

The three-day curated contemporary art fair, owned and produced by Redwood Art Group, will be the culminating event for the Santa Fe Art Week celebration

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Santa Fe, NM (April 24, 2023) – Redwood Art Group, the nation's leader in exhibitions and event production, media, and marketing for the global art community, announced today that Art Santa Fe, the three-day curated contemporary art fair, will take place at the Santa Fe Community Convention Center from Friday, July 14, to Sunday, July 16, 2023, and will be the culminating event to the Santa Fe Art Week celebration.

Art Santa Fe returns feature extraordinary art from around the world, specially curated programming, special events, and entertainment. The festivities kick off on Museum Hill at the International Folk Art Market, followed by a week of events, openings and shows, art talks and live demonstrations, and workshops at some of Santa Fe's 250+ galleries, cultural museums, and destinations.

Capping the Santa Fe Art Week celebration will be Art Santa Fe, Santa Fe's only contemporary fine art fair, bringing collectors and art fans from around the country to enjoy a dizzying array of exhibits, events, and live artwork demonstrations. More than 75+ national and international galleries and independent artists will showcase hundreds of extraordinary works from around the world. Here are a few exhibitors already confirmed that attendees can expect to see at Art Santa Fe 2023:

CONTEMPORARY ART PROJECTS USA (Miami, Florida)

Contemporary Art Projects USA (CAP) intends to keep their Art Santa Fe momentum going with a showcase of international artists. For more than a decade, CAP has been delighting Art Santa Fe's collectors with new original works and special installations from their celebrated artists.

- **Michele Voigt** is award winning, known for her electric images of the human experience. Driven by the human condition, she paints images of circumstance, choice, emotion, and fate, combined with the energy and influence of the past, all conjoined as a prism to the future. The work is a complex language of layering multiple levels of imagery, forming each of her signature style statement pieces.
- **Zammy Migdal** is a sculptor who has developed his artistic creativity in selfstanding sculptures and wall installations. His abstract art depicts images from his imagination as three-dimensional creations, bringing life and motion to new or recycled metal. Composition, equilibrium, and balance are the main qualities of his a, giving the viewer an experience the effects of color, form, and symbol.
- After 30 years, designing men's fashion, **Andre Croteau** has turned his seasoned instincts towards the fine arts. The study of "color and light" has long held a fascination. Light, and the way it interacts with colorful, abstract features is an integral part of every one of Croteau's artistic dialogues. Recently, Croteau has turned his textile signature and his artistic attentions upon organic sculpture. His first series, titled *Banyan* will be unveiled at Art Santa Fe 2023.

GALLERY EDEL (Osaka, Japan)

Gallery Edel has been showcasing Japanese contemporary art and international contemporary art in the United States for 20+ years. Delighting collectors and art aficionados with prominent international artists at Art Santa Fe for many of those years, Gallery Edel returns in 2023 with a slate of highly recognizable artists.

- Famed artist **Yayoi Kusama**, known for massive installations that have been showcased around the world, approachable glass sculptures, prints, and more, will be featured at Art Santa Fe, highlighting Kusama's intent for the artwork to be owned by all who love and appreciate it.
- Gallery Edel will also showcase other works by Andy Warhol, Damien Hirst, William Steiger, Takeshi Yamato, and others.

DAVID DISKO FINE ART (Albuquerque, New Mexico)

David Disko depicts landforms in a way that an amalgam of a cartographer, architect, and camouflage designer might. For two plus decades, his focus was on building construction. Returning to art, 15+ years ago gave him the opportunity to incorporate his career influences with his love of the imagery of landscape, geography, and nature. He believes a person's art should reflect what they know. He notices and knows — and his artwork tells the story.

MECENAVIE GALLERY (Paris, France)

Since 2004, Paris' Mecenavie Gallery has been serving talented contemporary artists, providing them with high quality services, including exhibitions in French and international art fairs, auction sales and corporate rentals. By striving to give artists opportunity at multiple levels, Mecenavie also gives art lovers and collectors the ability to enjoy, learn about, and collect art at fairs, online, and directly from the artist.

- **Claudine B** is a self-taught artist living in the Dordogne region of France. She draws in pastel, finding them fascinating, lively, and expressive. Finding inspiration from the first animal pastels discovered in the Lascaux caves, she rose to the challenge of becoming a professional animal pastel artist during the pandemic.
- **Corinne Pastout** hails from a family of artists both her mother and grandmother had numerous exhibitions throughout France. Infusing her paintings with an enigmatic, abstract, and innovative character, they depict a lively and colorful universe. The work is a mixture of traditional pointillist art, Aboriginal influence, bold colors, and a modernity all coming together on the canvas.
- Jeremy Tissier is a creator, professional musician for more than 20 years, videographer and art photographer. He chooses to study, independently and self-taught, black and chaos to bring out the light. The photographic pursuit of extraterrestrials, a taste for science fiction and desert nature have always been part of his sources of inspiration.
