ART SANTA FE 2023 ANNOUNCES ITS SCHEDULE OF PROGRAMMING

The Spotlight Program, Art Labs, Meet the Artists and Live Demonstrations make up a three-day program of interactive discovery

Santa Fe, NM – June 28, 2023: Redwood Art Group, the nation's leader in exhibitions and event production, media, and marketing for the global art community, announces the schedule of programming for its highly anticipated three-day showcase, **Art Santa Fe 2023**, taking place at the Santa Fe Convention Center, located at 201 W. Marcy Street in Santa Fe, from **Friday, July 14 to Sunday, July 16**. Advance tickets can now be purchased from \$20 by visiting <https://redwoodartgroup.com/art-santa-fe/>.

Art Santa Fe, now in its 23rd year, caps the Santa Fe Art Week celebration and is Santa Fe's only contemporary fine art fair, hosts collectors and art fans from around the country to enjoy a dizzying array of exhibits, events, and live artwork demonstrations. More than 75+ national and international galleries and independent artists will showcase hundreds of extraordinary works from around the world, including prints, paintings, drawings, sculptures, photography, ceramics, giclee, lithographs and glass works, among other contemporary and fine art.

"We couldn't be more thrilled to be hosting Art Santa Fe and partnering with the city to be part of the Santa Fe Art Week celebration," said Redwood's President and CEO Eric Smith. "We believe it will be an extraordinary week of events that visitors and collectors will enjoy. Art Santa Fe will be part of that experience, giving our guests an unforgettable exploration of world-class modern and contemporary art and capping an amazing Santa Fe Art Week in a city that boasts a vibrant creative scene."

This year's program features an extensive series of daily activities for attendees, that includes the **Spotlight Program**, a focused look at several cutting-edge galleries and artists chosen by the Redwood Art Group selection committee; **Art Labs**, a series of outstanding projects by leading galleries, art institutions, and art collectives within the fair; and **Meet The Artists and Live Demonstrations**, presenting an interactive experience—allowing attendees to get up-close-and-personal with the artists.

Attendees will have an opportunity to browse innovative new works of art and enjoy specific programming. **[SOLO]** offers established and emerging independent artists the opportunity to showcase their work, as an exceptional venue for independent artists to be discovered. Since its launch in 2016, the **Spotlight Program** has continued to be a highlight of Art Santa Fe's programming and events. This year's recipients are bringing their cutting-edge talent to the forefront of the art world. The five Spotlight Program recipients for 2023 include **Amanda Wood** (Booth 333), **Bernadette Youngquist** (Booth 223), **Dale M. Sumner** (Booth 420), and **Ruth Andre** (Booth 332).

This year's **Art Labs** features a series of outstanding projects by leading galleries, art institutions, and art collectives presented on-site within the fair, and include **Santa Fe Children's Museum Pop-Up** (Convention Center Lobby), **A Time for Africa** (Contemporary Art Projects USA, Entrance Area), **Redwood Art Collective** (Booths throughout the fair), **Unveiling The Save the Chimps' Wild Planet Collection** (Booth 505), and **ArtCollect** (Online Art Program). The Art Santa Fe **Discoveries Collection** presents a selection of unique discoveries from this year's artists and exhibitors, selected by the Art Santa Fe Curatorial Team as its favorite pieces of art—each one priced at \$1,000 or less.

A Time for Africa, from The African Spirit Collection, is a pop art inspired metaphor for the cultural colonization of Africa. The overall impression of the piece is that of a colorful, pop art-inspired textile mural, reminiscent of Fazzino's monumental JFK installations. At the heart of the piece is a symbolic mixing of European and African cultures, reflected through the integration of more-elegant, typically European evening fabrics with the more traditional everyday pattern work worn by many African cultures. Texture and an overall sculptural rhythm round the piece at the same time that they symbolize the ebb and flow of the overall global cultural process, further reinforced by the overall pop-cultural inspiration of the piece.
