The three-day curated contemporary art fair, owned and produced by Redwood Art Group, will be the culminating event for the Santa Fe Art Week celebration

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Santa Fe, NM (April 29, 2024) – Redwood Art Group, the nation’s leader in exhibitions and event production, media, and marketing for the global art community, announced today that Art Santa Fe, the three-day curated contemporary art fair, will take place at the Santa Fe Community Convention Center from Friday, July 12, to Sunday, July 14, 2024, one of the leading events of Santa Fe’s annual Art Week celebration.

Art Santa Fe returns feature extraordinary art from around the world, specially curated programming, special events, and entertainment. Art Santa Fe, Santa Fe’s only contemporary fine art fair, bringing collectors and art fans from around the country to enjoy a dizzying array of exhibits, events, and live artwork demonstrations. More than 85+ national and international galleries and independent artists will showcase hundreds of extraordinary works from around the world. Whether a gallery or an independent artist exhibiting, Art Santa Fe is where you can meet the

artist, learn about their work, and support the artists when you add their work to your collection Here are a few not-to-be-missed exhibitors that attendees can expect to see at Art Santa Fe 2024:

CONTEMPORARY ART PROJECTS USA (Miami, Florida)

Contemporary Art Projects USA (CAP) intends to keep their Art Santa Fe momentum going with a showcase of international artists. For more than a decade, CAP has been delighting Art Santa Fe's collectors with new original works and special installations from their celebrated artists.

- **Carola Orieta Sperman** transforms acrylic, an inert material, into an object that reflects life, connecting to the shapes of organic forms that expand into an imaginary realm. Each piece becomes a living organism that performs in flowing unpredictable undulations, guided by a dynamic and free-generated energy.
- **Karina Sztein's** artwork springs from her architectural background and transforms into abstractions in textiles and color. The result is a subtle rhythm — a rhythm of silences, pauses, and spaces.
- **Eduardo Dayan** is a Mexican photographer that has transformed his images into a riot of sophistication and color on tempered glass, creating shapes, figures, and colors that can clearly be alien to reality — but intriguing.

GALLERY EDEL (Osaka, Japan)

Gallery Edel has been showcasing Japanese contemporary art and international contemporary art in the United States for 20+ years. Delighting collectors and art aficionados with prominent international artists at Art Santa Fe for many of those years, Gallery Edel returns in 2024 with a slate of highly recognizable artists.

- Famed artist **Yayoi Kusama**, known for massive installations that have been showcased around the world, approachable glass sculptures, prints, and more, will be featured at Art Santa Fe, highlighting Kusama's intent for the artwork to be owned by all who love and appreciate it.
- Gallery Edel will also showcase other works by Andy Warhol, Damien Hirst, William Steiger, Takeshi Yamato, and others.

DAVID DISKO FINE ART (Albuquerque, New Mexico)

David Disko depicts landforms in a way that an amalgam of a cartographer, architect, and camouflage designer might. For two plus decades, his focus was on building construction. Returning to art, 15+ years ago gave him the opportunity to incorporate his career influences with his love of the imagery of landscape, geography, and nature. He believes a person's art should reflect what they know. He notices and knows — and his artwork tells the story.

PALETTE CONTEMPORARY ART AND CRAFT (Albuquerque, New Mexico)

Palette Contemporary Art & Craft is an art gallery located in Albuquerque, NM. We feature an international collection of fine art glass, original paintings, limited edition

prints, ceramics, and jewelry by both emerging and renown artists.

- **Stefan Geissbuhler** works out of his studio near Denver, Colorado. He describes his work as New-Century Modern, a combination of Mid-Century Modern aesthetic and echoes of Abstract Expressionism.
- **Barbara Zaring** has honed her skills over the past 40 years alongside different ways of viewing the world — always informed by nature, Zen Buddhism, and living in northern New Mexico.
- **Yukako Kojima** is a glass sculptor whose fascination with color and natural light infuse every piece of her work. By using light, the attractive quality if the piece is no longer contained just to the inside, but expands to the outside, demonstrating the relationship of light and glass.

“We are pleased to once again host Art Santa Fe and partner with the city to be part of the Santa Fe Art Week celebration,” said Redwood’s President and CEO Eric Smith. “We’re excited to contribute to the city’s vibrant creative scene and give visitors and collectors an opportunity to experience world-class modern and contemporary art.”
