**ART SANTA FE MARKS ITS 26TH EDITION
AS A KEY OPENING OF SANTA FE ART WEEK**

*A Leading Contemporary Fair Kicks Off Santa Fe Art Week with
Global Exhibitors and Programming*

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Santa Fe (May 3, 2026) – Redwood Art Group, the nation’s leader in art exhibitions, event production, media, and marketing for the global art community, today announced the return of **Art Santa Fe**, the three-day curated contemporary art fair, for its 26th edition. The fair will take place Thursday, July 9 through Saturday, July 11, 2026, at the Santa Fe Community Convention Center, serving as a premier opening event of Santa Fe Art Week.

Art Santa Fe will showcase extraordinary contemporary art from around the world alongside specially curated programming, immersive experiences, and dynamic events. As a cornerstone of Art Week, the fair offers collectors and art enthusiasts a compelling entry point into Santa Fe’s vibrant cultural scene—where deeply rooted artistic traditions meet cutting-edge contemporary work.

Taking place July 9–19, 2026, Santa Fe Art Week transforms the city into a global art destination, featuring more than 100 events spanning visual, performing, literary, and culinary arts. The celebration begins with Art Santa Fe and the renowned International Folk Art Market, followed by a full schedule of gallery openings, talks, demonstrations, and workshops hosted by the Santa Fe Gallery Association across the city’s 250+ galleries, museums, and cultural venues.

As Santa Fe’s only contemporary fine art fair, Art Santa Fe draws collectors from across the country to experience a diverse range of exhibitions, live demonstrations, and interactive programming. More than 70 national and international galleries and

independent artists will present hundreds of works, offering attendees the opportunity to meet artists, gain insight into their practice, and acquire new work directly.

Featured exhibitors for the 2026 edition include:

CONTEMPORARY ART GALLERY (Miami, Florida)

Contemporary Art Projects USA (CAP) returns with a curated presentation of international artists. For more than a decade, CAP has engaged Art Santa Fe collectors with original works and immersive installations from its roster of celebrated artists.

SCOTT RISPIN FINE ART (Queen Creek, Arizona)

Scott has been a working professional in nearly every aspect of the commercial arts; from ad agencies to silk screening, custom graphics/signage to sought-after muralist. Through juxtapositions of paper-thin application to thick, muscular textures, everything is open to potential abstraction; shape, form and color. Color harmonies and movement/counter-movement are always at play in Rispin's paintings.

ARTAVITA / WORLD WIDE ART (Santa Barbara, California)

Artavita was created by a team of international gallery owners and artists who wanted to design a space where artists could come together and display their work. Artavita presents a diverse international collection, including fine art glass, paintings, prints, ceramics, and sculpture by both emerging and established artists.

"We are excited to present Art Santa Fe's 26th edition and to partner with the city as part of Santa Fe Art Week," said Eric Smith, President and CEO of Redwood Art Group.
